In today's complex conditions of market relations, regional enterprises need complex project management and, accordingly, a model for evaluating the effectiveness of their activities [1]. This project management methodology will enable enterprises at the regional level to increase economic efficiency in such vectors [7]:

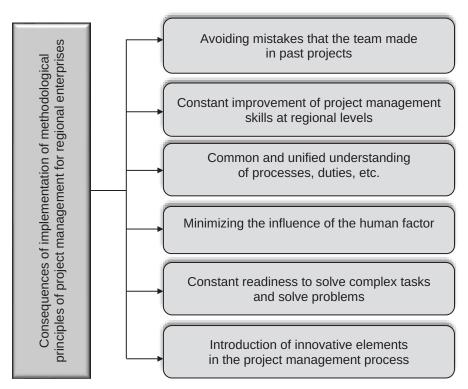


Fig. 1. Consequences of implementation of methodological principles of project management for regional enterprises

- regional innovation strategies;
- potential economic and financial opportunities;
- the personal contribution of interested parties to the management of local business projects.

The main provisions regarding the methodological principles of project management of regional enterprises can be summarized as follows:

- 1. The wrong way to manage the project at the regional level is the lack of results. The success of an ill-conceived or ill-conceived project can destroy corporate value.
- 2. The organizational environment of regional-level enterprises has a profound effect on the results of projects. This especially applies to such aspects as the structure of the enterprise, financial capabilities, competence of personnel.
- 3. Both short-term and long-term goals should be taken into account when managing projects.
- 4. Methodological principles of project management should include corporate agreement between portfolios, programs, projects and individual tasks.
- 5. Corporate management of regional enterprises is carried out through the implementation of numerous projects that adapt to the effective implementation of defined strategies.

Conclusions from the conducted research. Thus, the methodological principles of project management of regional enterprises in modern conditions are the correct organization, step-by-step planning, management and control of processes, coordination of labour, financial and material and technical resources throughout the project cycle, aimed at the effective achievement of goals through the use of innovative methods, management techniques and technologies to achieve certain results regarding the composition and volume of work, cost, time, quality and satisfaction of project participants. Therefore, all economic transformations cannot be imagined without the application of project management implementation methodology. It is the methodological principles and innovative approaches to project management at the regional level that make it possible to solve complex reform tasks in conditions of limited resources and time.
